

Instructions For Using Your Self-proving Will Affidavit

New Hampshire allows the use of a self-proving Affidavit. By having your witnesses to your Will join you in appearing before a Notary Public and signing this Affidavit under oath, you can waive the requirement for one or more of your witnesses to appear before a court to acknowledge proper execution of your Will. This can be done at the same time as signing your Will or at any later date.

This is an entirely optional procedure. If you believe you will likely be creating a new Will in the foreseeable future, it may not be worth the time, money and effort to make this Will self proving. Whether or not you use this Affidavit does not affect the validity of your Will.
